This manual belongs to the MonkeyGo. It is about the correct use of the product. The MonkeyGo is made to be used in airplanes, busses, trains and on chairs. NOT for use in cars, the MonkeyGo is not a safety or restraint device.







STEP 1: HOW TO INFLATE?

Find the inflate nozzles at both sides of the MonkeyGo. Pull it out to inflate. Tip: you can use the deflate nozzle on the back of the MonkeyGo to inflate as well. This is easier and faster because there is no resistance. To finish please use the inflate nozzles.





STEP 2: HOW TO ATTACH IT?

Place the MonkeyGo on the seat and attach the strap around the back. You can tighten it up.





STEP 3: WHAT TO USE THE RING FOR

The ring on the side of the MonkeyGo can be used to attach a toy or nozzle to it.







STEP 4: UNSTRAP AND DEFLATE

Unstrap the MonkeyGo from the chair and deflate it by pulling out the deflate nozzle on the back. It will deflate immediately. Stow it back in the MonkeyGo bag or backpack and enjoy your destination.

WHEN USED IN AIRPLANE:





FASTEN THE SEATBELT

When your child is seated fasten the airplane seatbelt over the MonkeyGo. Now you are ready to enjoy a nice, comfortable and relaxed flight together.



WHAT IF THE AIR PRESSURE DIFFERS?

During take-off and landing the cabin air pressure may differ. This may affect the pressure of the MonkeyGo as well. You can regulate the pressure by using the inflate nozzles on both sides.

WARNINGS AND ADVICES



- · Always fasten seat belt
- MonkeyGo is NOT a Child Restraint System (CRS)

TIPS & TRICKS

- Simply attach a toy or nozzle to the ring to keep your child busy
- Place a blanket in between your chair and the chair in front of you so the child gets a tent above him, it will be darker and they think it is fun!
- You can use the deflate nozzle on the back of the MonkeyGo to inflate as well. This is easier and faster because there is no resistance. To finish please use the inflate nozzles.
